





Wally was a graduate of the Bronx School of Science and City College of New York. A US Army Veteran, he served during the Korean War and was part of the Army Audit Agency.

Wally, a CPA, practiced accounting in Monticello and Liberty for 20

years, and was an active stakeholder in civic community organizations. Wally began serving on the New Hope Community's Board of Directors in 1989.

During his tenure, he served as Board Chair from 1994 to 2004 and as assistant secretary from 2005 to 2008.






Sensory Garden at New Hope Community Coming Summer 2019



New Hope Community is excited to announce plans for the creation of a Sensorv Garden at our location in Loch Sheldrake, New York, Sullivan County. Sensory gardens create a beautiful outdoor space that fuses the interaction between a person's five senses (taste, smell, touch, hearing and sight) and a diverse array of elements which celebrate the gifts of nature



and enhance one's sense of harmony, balance and peace. We have launched our fundraising campaign with a goal of raising \$200,000



by May 1st, 2019. This will cover the full cost of our 1.5 acre garden and ensure a space that will dynamically provide opportunities to enjoy a multitude of sensory experiences within a lush, green
